

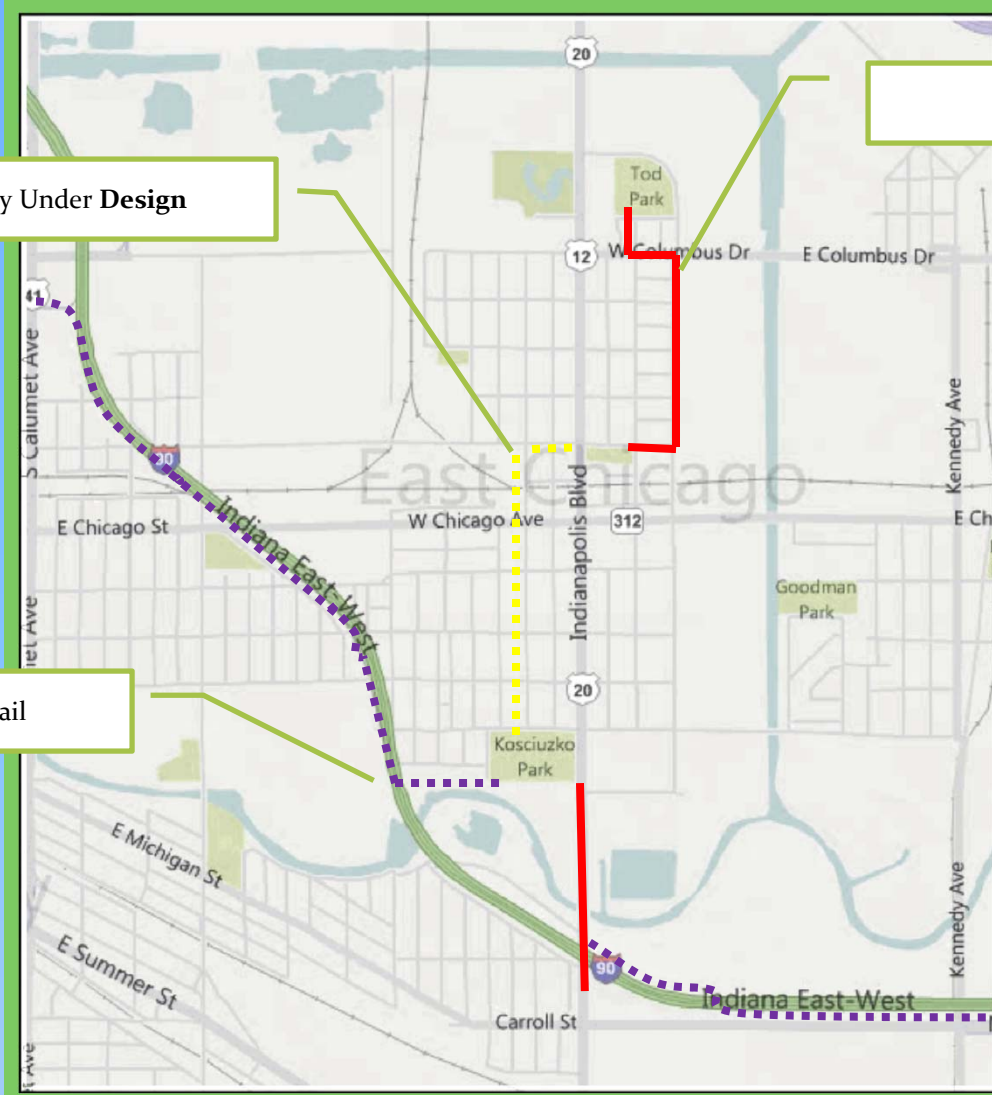

EAST CHICAGO BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN TRAIL PROJECT

- The **purpose** of this project is to provide a safe, inexpensive and environmentally positive method of transportation within the City.
- Currently there are few linkages for bicycle and pedestrian traffic between Tod Park, Veterans Memorial Park, Kosciusko Park, and the NICTD East Chicago Station.

EAST CHICAGO BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN TRAIL PROJECT

- The only links are shared roadways heavily traveled by motorized traffic; creating an unsafe traffic situation for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians.

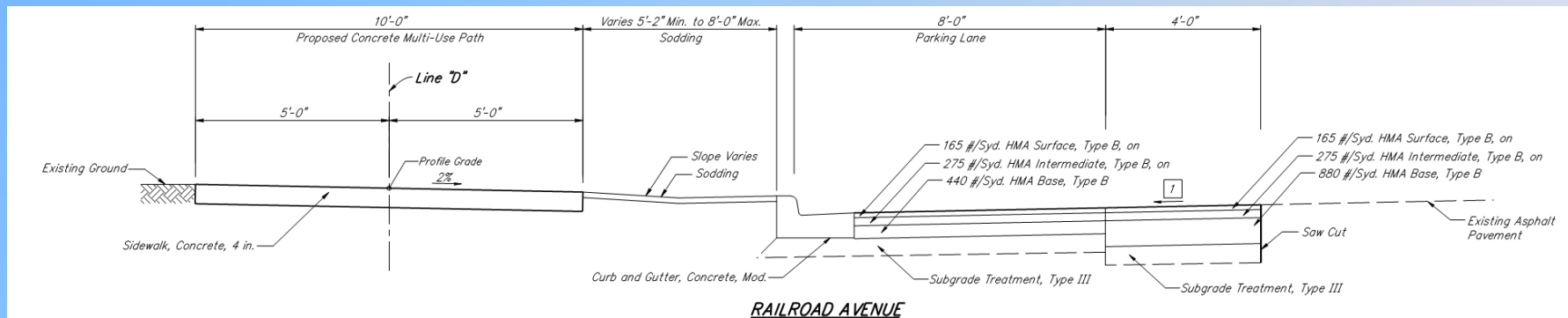
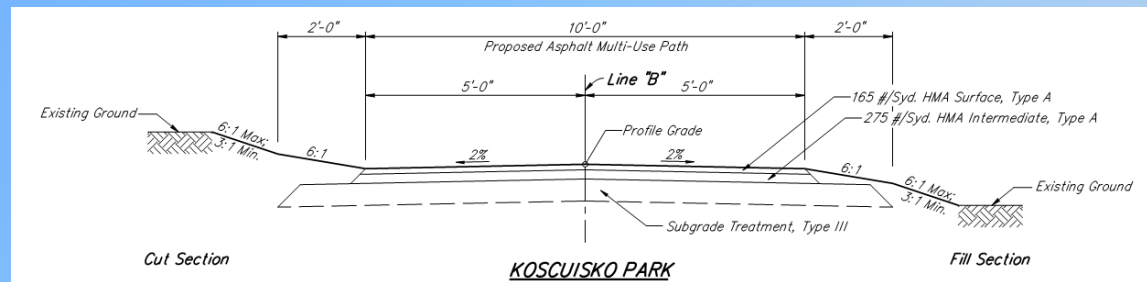
- The **need** for this project is to provide a safe transportation facility for bicyclists while enhancing general safety.



EAST CHICAGO BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN TRAIL PROJECT

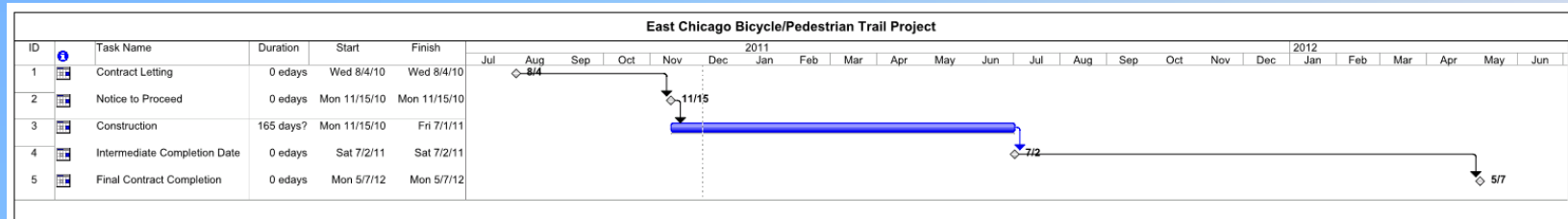
- Project Scope:
 - Construction of approx. 1.90 miles of a 10'-0" wide, multi-use path, through an urban corridor.
 - Reconfiguration of parking along Railroad Avenue
 - Context Sensitive Design
 - Veterans Memorial Park
 - Kosciusko Park
 - Amenities
 - Benches, Seat Wall, Trash Receptacles, Bike Racks, etc.
