# Remember, only Rain in the Drain!

### Shortcuts to Natural Lawn Care

1. Mow your lawn at 3 inches or higher.
2. Leave your grass clippings on your lawn.
3. Spot treat weeds instead of spraying the entire lawn.
4. Keep fertilizer off sidewalks and driveways.
5. Test your soil for fertilizer needs.
6. Water no more than 1 inch per week, including rain.

### 5 Ways to Help Reduce Air Pollution

1. **Take Care of your Car.** Changing the oil and checking the tire pressure can improve gas mileage and could reduce your car's emissions by more than half.
1. **Trip Chain.** Combine errands into one trip. Starting a car that has been sitting for an hour or longer pollutes up to five times more than a warm engine.
2. **Don't top off the tank.** The extra gas fumes increase ground level ozone.
3. **Get fuel when it's cool.** Refueling in the evening can prevent gas fumes from heating up and creating ground level ozone.
4. **Know before you go.** Get travel updates before you leave to avoid traffic congestion.
5. **Share a ride.** Carpooling a few times a week will decrease traffic congestion, reduce pollution and save money.
