### **Organization:**

The Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission (NIRPC) is the Council of Government and Metropolitan Planning Organization for a region of nearly 800,000 people in Lake, Porter, and LaPorte Counties of Indiana and part of the Chicago Metropolitan Area. NIRPC provides a forum that enables the citizens of Northwest Indiana to address regional issues relating to transportation, the environment and economic development.

### **Internship details:**

The summer semester internships will be offered from approximately May 28, 2019 to August 2, 2019 at 35 hours per week. Interns should be current students in urban planning or civil engineering with a focus on transportation. Contingent upon successful intern performance, the internship may be extended into the fall, provided that fall matriculation is anticipated, and budget at NIRPC is available. Internship activities will include some or all of the following planning activities:

- a) Transportation data collection in the field or through research;
- b) Geographic Information System data collection, update and/or analysis;
- c) Opportunities to attend and participate in public outreach activities and meetings with a wide variety of public officials.
